- Why do you think the MDRT Foundation should fund this charity? If you are familiar with the specific project for which they seek funding, tell us about why we should fund this project in particular.
- Do you have a personal connection to the issue or population that the charity is addressing?

Recommended letter length: 1 page (350-500 words)
